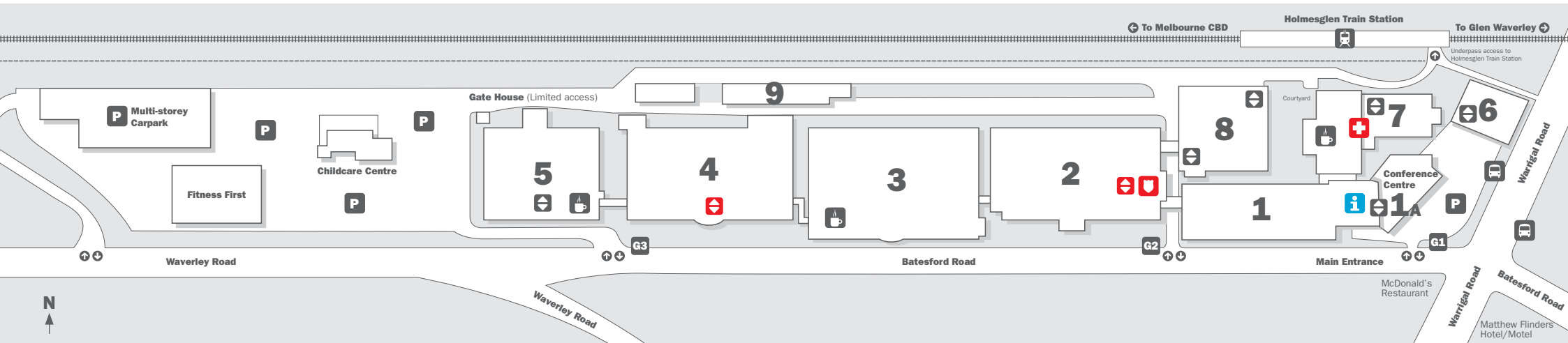

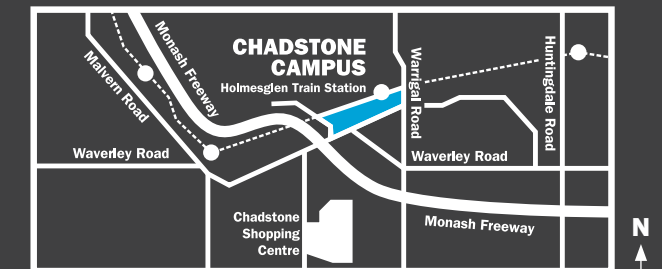
GETTING HERE
