



PUBLIC TRANSPORT


Train

The Glen Waverley station is the nearest train station to the Glen Waverley campus. From the station, you may take Bus 623 which travels along Waverley Road to the Glen Waverley campus.

Bus

The Glen Waverley campus is approximately a 15 minute walk from the Glen Waverley station which is accessible via the following bus routes:

- 623 Glen Waverley to St Kilda via Mount Waverley, Chadstone, Carnegie
- 734 Glen Iris to Glen Waverley
- 736 Mitcham to Blackburn via Vermont South, Glen Waverley, Forest Hill
- 737 Croydon to Monash University via Boronia, Knox City Shopping Centre, Glen Waverley
- 742 Eastland to Chadstone via Vermont South, Glen Waverley, Oakleigh
- 753 Glen Waverley to Bayswater via Wheelers Hill, Knoxfield, Boronia
- 754 Rowville to Glen Waverley via Wheelers Hill
- 850 Dandenong to Glen Waverley via Mulgrave, Brandon Park
- 885 Glen Waverley to Springvale via Wanda Street
- 902 Chelsea to Airport West via Glen Waverley
