

Holmesglen Asylum Seeker Scholarship 2024

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Scholarship value is \$2,000 for Certificate IV and below courses to go towards fees and educational related materials and \$2,000 for Diploma level courses to go towards fees.
- Any monetary payment the student may receive is to be spent towards educational related materials such as textbooks, tools, uniform and/or to assist with financial hardship.
- Scholarship award is non-transferable and the scholarship amount will only be awarded once the student has enrolled in each semester. If the student withdraws from the course, they are no longer eligible to receive the scholarship amount.
- An applicant may only be awarded one scholarship during their study at Holmesglen.
- All correspondence will be via email, including acknowledgement of receipt of applications.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- The Scholarship committee meets monthly to assess scholarship applications
- Funds are limited and subject to availability

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

An applicant must be either:

- Seeking asylum and currently hold a bridging visa with the right to study;
- Hold a Safe Haven Enterprise Visa (SHEV); or
- Hold a Temporary Protection Visa (TPV)
- Applicants can be current or prospective students of Holmesglen
- Applicants who are a family member of a Holmesglen employee or agent are not eligible to apply
- Applicants cannot be a recipient of any other scholarship or award

Documentary evidence is required to support your application, including:

- For SHEV and TPV holders, a copy of this visa is required.
- For people seeking asylum holding a current bridging visa, evidence such as a VEVO check or copy of the bridging visa is required to confirm protection application has been lodged and the person has the right to study.
- If already enrolled, please also supply a copy of your statement of fees (You can get this from the info office).

SELECTION PROCESS

1. Applicants are required to complete the Holmesglen Asylum Seeker Scholarship Application Form and attach their additional supporting documents.
2. **Included in the application form, please write and tell us, in no more than 500 words, why you have chosen the course and what completing the course will do for your future and how receiving a scholarship would benefit you in relation to your studies.**
3. Applicants are recommended to request the assistance of a Student Counsellor to complete their application.
4. Submit application and documentation to Student Wellbeing at Chadstone, Moorabbin, Glen Waverley or Bourke St campuses or by email to studentwellbeing@holmesglen.edu.au by the application close date.
5. The Holmesglen Scholarship review panel will assess all applications and make a final decision on whether the application is successful or unsuccessful.
6. Successful applicants will be notified in writing via email.
7. The decision of the Holmesglen Scholarship review panel is final and no further communication will be entered into.
